



Summer Student Nurse Internship Program 2023

Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare is pleased to announce the return of its Summer Student Nurse Internship Program. The Summer Student Nurse Internship is designed for registered nursing students who have completed, or will complete by June, one semester of nursing school with at least one clinical rotation and who is within 18 months of graduating. During this 8-week paid summer program, interns will work three 12-hour shifts or four 10-hour shifts weekly with an RN partner in various clinical areas. The program will run June 4 - July 28 with mandatory orientation the week prior to starting.

Eligibility and Qualifications

- Currently enrolled in either a BSN or ADN accredited nursing program and be in good standing
- Must have completed at least one semester of nursing school
- Must have completed at least one clinical rotation
- Anticipated graduation date within 18 months (by Summer 2024)
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Must hold a current BLS certification for healthcare providers from the American Heart Association or the American Red Cross

Primary Accountabilities

The student nurse intern will function under the direct supervision of a registered nurse. The intern will follow all policies and procedures of TMH and actively support a commitment to the mission and vision of TMH, consistently displaying behaviors in harmony with the ICARE values of Integrity, Compassion, Accountability, Respect and Excellence. The intern will be responsible for assisting patients with activities of daily living and for maintaining an environment conducive to the patient's safety. Other duties may be assigned as directed by the RN.

Program Details

Tallahassee Memorial Healthcare Summer Nurse Interns will be placed with a mentor RN in clinical areas. Every effort will be made to place interns in their area of interest but not guaranteed. The nurse intern will gain valuable experience and exposure to various clinical areas as well as afforded unique opportunities for hands-on patient care as well as observation experiences.

- 36-40 hours per week; variable shifts which may include nights and/or weekends
- Interns will be assigned to a RN mentor and will work their schedule
- Shadowing and mentoring opportunities
- Hands-on patient care experience under the direction of an RN
