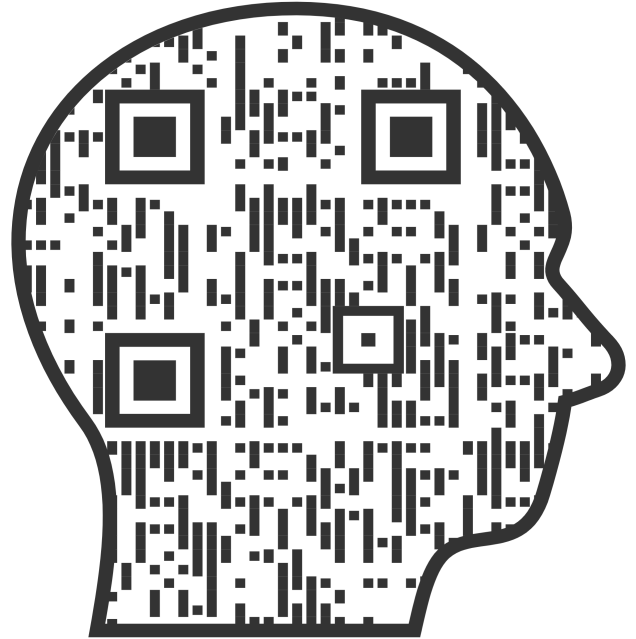


Anxious kids (age 9-12)

Hello Families! Does your child (1) worry excessively, (2) get anxious in social situations, or (3) have obsessions or compulsions? The Psychology Department at Florida State University is recruiting anxious kids to participate in a research study (with a parent or guardian).

We interview a parent/guardian by phone (up to 90 minutes, paid \$20/hr in Amazon gift cards) to see if your child is eligible for the lab visit (one time for 1-4 hours).

In the lab visit, you and your child will fill out surveys, and your child will play a computer game and do a balance recovery task while we record muscle and brain activity using sensors placed on the skin and scalp. Some children will also watch a 45-minute video.

At the end of the visit, your child will pick a small toy prize and you will be paid \$20/hr in cash.
