





Study Information

We are exploring how
HippoCamera, a smartphone app,
can help enhance memory and
improve mood in older adults with
depression by replaying daily life
events, and using EEG to assess
autobiographical sentiments.

Eligibility Criteria

- Older adults ages 65+
- Fluent in English
- No history of seizures
- Currently have depression or have been recently diagnosed with depression by a healthcare professional
- Own a smartphone with a camera





What is EEG?

Electroencephalography (EEG) is a non-invasive neuroimaging technique that measures electrical activity of the brain.

No pokes, pricks, or anything painful is involved.

You will wear a cap that looks and feels like a swim cap. Gel will then be applied to your scalp to help the sensors read your brain waves.
