

The Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare Institutional Review Board (IRB) is responsible for conducting the ethical review of human subjects research being conducted at TMH to ensure research participants' rights, safety and welfare are protected.

Protocols for human subjects research will be subject to IRB fees. Fees may be charged to applicants as established by the Office of Research. All fees are non-refundable regardless of the study being approved by the IRB. IRB fees should be considered in the budgeting process when developing the study protocol.

EFFECTIVE January 1, 2021 the TMH IRB fee schedule is as follows:

Fees are paid by check, credit card or journal transfer to the TMH IRB. The fees paid by check are made payable to TMH.

## **IRB FEE WAIVERS**

In rare cases under exceptional circumstances, a fee reduction or waiver may be requested. IRB fees may be waived on a case-by-case basis for single-patient use, emergency use, and unfunded protocols by the TMH Office of Research. Principal Investigators requesting a fee waiver must explain the circumstance surrounding the need for a fee waiver. ## TMH INVESTIGATOR INITIATED & RESIDENT STUDIES

TMH Investigator initiated studies (unfunded) will not be charged IRB fees. TMH Residents initiating minimal risk studies will not be charged IRB fees.
